Frequently asked questions

1. Is the £400,000 maximum limit the 80% fEC figure or the 100% fEC figure?

£400,000 is the 80% fEC figure.

2. Can an organisation submit more than one application?

It is possible for an organisation to submit more than one application.

- a) Does an application have to cover all of the three capabilities: Federated analysis, AI and semi automated output checking, and TRE reference architecture and implementations?

Applications do not have to cover all of the three capabilities. They must cover one or more.

3. Can a subcontractor be a Co-I on an application?

A subcontractor can not be a Co-I on an application. Please refer to [UKRI guidelines](#) for more information.

4. Can a subcontractor claim 100% fEC

Under [UKRI guidelines](#), a subcontractor cannot claim 100% fEC. Subcontractors are paid at 80% fEC.

5. Does an application have to include PIE plans?

As per the [call specification](#), applications do not have to include PIE plans.

“PIE plans are not mandatory for a successful application, there will be significant PIE activities as part of the DARE UK Transformational Programme (see Background) and, more broadly, in Phase 2 of the programme. We expect successful applicants to commit to engaging with those activities where appropriate”

6. Does an application have to be linked to one of the three capabilities in the Transformational Programme: Core Components (TRevolution) or can it propose something new?

The focus of this call is testing and adoption capabilities developed by TRevolution. Applications which do not support TRe early adoption efforts of TRevolution's capabilities will not be funded.
